

Unclaimed Dividend

The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has introduced Section 205C of the Companies Act, 1956, through Companies (Amendment) Act, 1999, thereby making it compulsory to deposit unclaimed amounts of Shareholders lying with the Companies for a period of seven years to the Investor Education and Protection Fund (IEPF), administered by the Central Government.

Further, MCA has issued a Circular dated May 10, 2012, notifying the Rule “Investor Education and Protection Fund (Uploading of information regarding unpaid and unclaimed amounts lying with Companies) Rules, 2012”. As per this Rule, company is required to identify and upload details of unclaimed dividend on their website.
